



WAC 197-11-970: DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Description of Proposal: The Project site is on and adjacent to King County's Skyway Park in unincorporated King County. The Skyway Water and Sewer District proposes to consolidate three existing sewer pump stations located along the periphery of the Park into one (existing) pump station. Proposed work includes constructing new gravity sewer pipelines to convey the sewer flow from two of the existing pump station sites to the District's existing pump station (known as the Main Station) located on a property adjacent to the northern end of Skyway Park. This project also replaces the Main Station and its associated force main pipeline with new facilities. The Main Pump Station will be replaced at the existing pump station site. The new force main will predominately be parallel to the proposed gravity sewer pipes. The project is intended to improve sewage conveyance to one central pump station facility, improve maintenance access, reduce infiltration and inflow (I & I), reduce energy consumption, and reduce long-term operating and maintenance costs for the District. As part of the project, the District will also replace an existing 1940's vintage water main that bisects Skyway Park with a proposed 12-inch water main. Wetland and stream impacts will be mitigated as part of the project.

Proponent: Skyway Water & Sewer District

Location of Proposal, including street address, if any: The project site is located in the Skyway Park Addition and Seelye Addition neighborhoods on and adjacent to King County Skyway Park in Skyway, Washington, in Section 12, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M. Roadways bordering the site include Renton Avenue South, South 125th Street, 70th to 72nd Avenue South, and South 120th Place.

Lead Agency: Skyway Water & Sewer District

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
